Town 9 jumped out fast in game one posting a quick 5-0 lead after two innings behind Andy Duthie and Jason Roecker. Big Guys cut the lead to 5-3 after four innings, but wouldn't score again as Town 9 piled it on and finished with a 14-3 victory. Roecker 4-6 in game one while Doug Fiedler collected four runs batted in.

The Tappers came out screaming again in game two, once again behind Duthie and Roecker, taking a 6-3 lead into the 5th inning. BG6.9 chipped away and tied the game 6-6 behind the hitting of Kevin Roecker and Travis Steger. Batting in the bottom of the 6th inning with the score tied, Town 9 put up a 4-spot in the 6th, a solo tallie in the 7th and looked to have a safe 11-6 lead heading into the top of the 9th inning...three outs away from a title. BG6.9, backs against the wall, strung together 5 singles before Chris Becker cleared the bases with a clutch triple, tying the game at 11-11. Leadoff hitter Brad Kaul calmly banged a single, scoring Becker for a 12-11 lead. Lucas Antonioni led off the bottom of the 9th frame with a single, and immediately scored on a Bruce Friesch triple, tying this classic at 12-12. After failing to score in the top of the 10th inning, The 6.9ers could only watch as Fiedler drove in Keith Moldenhauer, giving Town 9 a 13-12 victory, and a Country Dartball League Championship.

Kevin Roecker 5-6 in game two for Big Guys, while Duthie was 4-6 with 4 RBI's to power Town 9 Tap. Duthie was named The Championship Game MVP.
