Presentation From The 2016 Induction Ceremony

Ron Olszewski – Lives in Colgate, WI. Started playing Dartball around 1956. Has played in the Catholic Blue & Gold , Western Suburban, Country, Hillcrest 4-man, and Rock River 4-man Dartball Leagues over the past 60 years, sometimes playing 4 nights a week. His best season average was in 1998 when he batted .570, with many years over .500. He has been on over 22 league champion teams, won 5 league batting titles, and 4 RBI titles. He is an avid tournament player, and also a 2 time class B state champion, with Hillcrest in 1988, and 2013 when he managed the Studz team. He has been a major supporter of Dartball in the Washington and Waukesha County areas by managing and helping assemble teams, helping with boards and darts, and bringing new players into the game.

Championship Day-March 31

3 matches were played to determine the Champions of the Country Dartball League for the 2015-16 season. These games ended a 19-week regular season and a 3-week playoff season.

In the Consolation Bracket final, Fat Charlies 2 went on the road and took care of business defeating Slinger House 1 by the scores of 7-2 and 4-3. Fat Charlie's reached the Championship game by cruising over Kenicky's 1 and #1 seed Madam Belles, winning all of their games on the road.

On the other side of the wall in Slinger, Regular season Champion Slinger House 2 hosted Sheryl's Club 175 in the 3rd Place game. Sheryl's jumped out big in game 1 winning 16-8. Slinger House 2 evened the match with a 10-7 win in game 2. A football game broke out in the deciding game with Sheryl's prevailing in a slug fest by the score of 21-14. Bruce Frank, Elliot Frank, and Dana Schlieve each had 9 hits for Sheryl's while combining for 22 RBI.

In an old school match-up for the Championship Game, red hot Tom's Bar headed south to Richfield to face Pioneer Bowl. These two teams' rosters combined for over 700 years of dartball shooting experience coming into the Championship game. Pioneer Bowl rolled in Game 1 by a score of 13-5. Pioneer Bowl jumped out quick in Game 2 soaring to a 10-0 lead heading into the bottom of the 3rd. Keyed by a 2-run triple by Mike Kuepper, Toms scored 5 runs in the bottom of the inning to cut the lead in half. However, Pioneer Bowl went on to score 4 runs in the 4th, 2 runs in the 5th, 2 runs in the 6th to take a commanding 18-5 lead. Toms did make a rally with a 6-run 8th Inning, but it wasn't enough as Pioneer finished off the Championship by winning 20-12.

Kim Schmitt finished the night going 8 for 11 including 5-5 on the Single. Mark Rubusch, Mark Gettleman and George Hanson each contributed 7 hits for Pioneer Bowl in the 2-game sweep.

Mark Gettleman was named the 2016 Playoffs MVP as he batted .655 in 6 games including a whopping 17-19 on the Single.

The Annual Country Dartball League Mid-season 9-person Dartball Tournament was held on January 30, 2016 at the Sterling Chalet in Richfield. 15 of the 20 Country Dartball League teams participated in this year's 9-hour event.

Slinger House 2 (Slinger) and Sheryl's Club 175 (Ackerville) dominated their respective "Pool Play" games with 7-0 and 5-1 records respectively. Slinger House 2 rolled through the Championship Bracket into the finals with wins over Lone Star (Germantown) and Sportscorner 1 (Germantown) to face Toms Bar (Slinger). Toms Bar reached the finals by defeating Kruegers (Menomonee Falls) and Sheryls Club 175.

In the Championship game, Toms Bar took a commanding 7-0 lead and still led 8-5 going to the bottom of the 7th inning before all heck broke out for Slinger House 2. Jeff Aulenbacher's single tied the game at 8-8 before Jay Aulenbacher ripped a go-ahead triple. Slinger House 2 scored 7 runs in the inning and never looked back for a 12-8 win.
